

How to Sign Up for Medicare Through Social Security

Step 1: Go to the SSA Checklist

Step 2: Click 'Apply Online' or 'Get Started' for Part B only

Select the dropdown '**Information you'll need to provide**' to know what information is required

Step 3: Agree to Terms and Apply

At the "Apply for Benefits" page, you can follow the 'Getting Ready' steps, view a Video Introduction, or read articles for more information



Step 4: Your Application

Applying for Medicare will take approximately 10-30 minutes. You may save as you go, to take a break



Step 5: Follow-Up

Once you submit, you are able to check on the status of your online application by logging into your my Social Security account. A SSA representative may reach out to confirm your information on the application

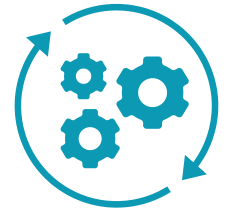

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AUTOMATIC ENROLLMENT



If you are already receiving Social Security Income 90 days prior to the month of your 65th birthday you will:

- Be automatically enrolled in both Parts A & B
- Receive your Medicare Card in the mail
- Receive an option to delay Part B



ADVANTAGES TO ONLINE ENROLLMENT

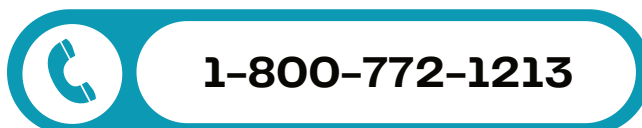
If you are not receiving Social Security Income:

- Contact Social Security Administration 90 days before the month of your 65th birthday
- You may choose to delay Part B if you continue to work at an employer with 20 or more employees; that have creditable health plan coverage.
